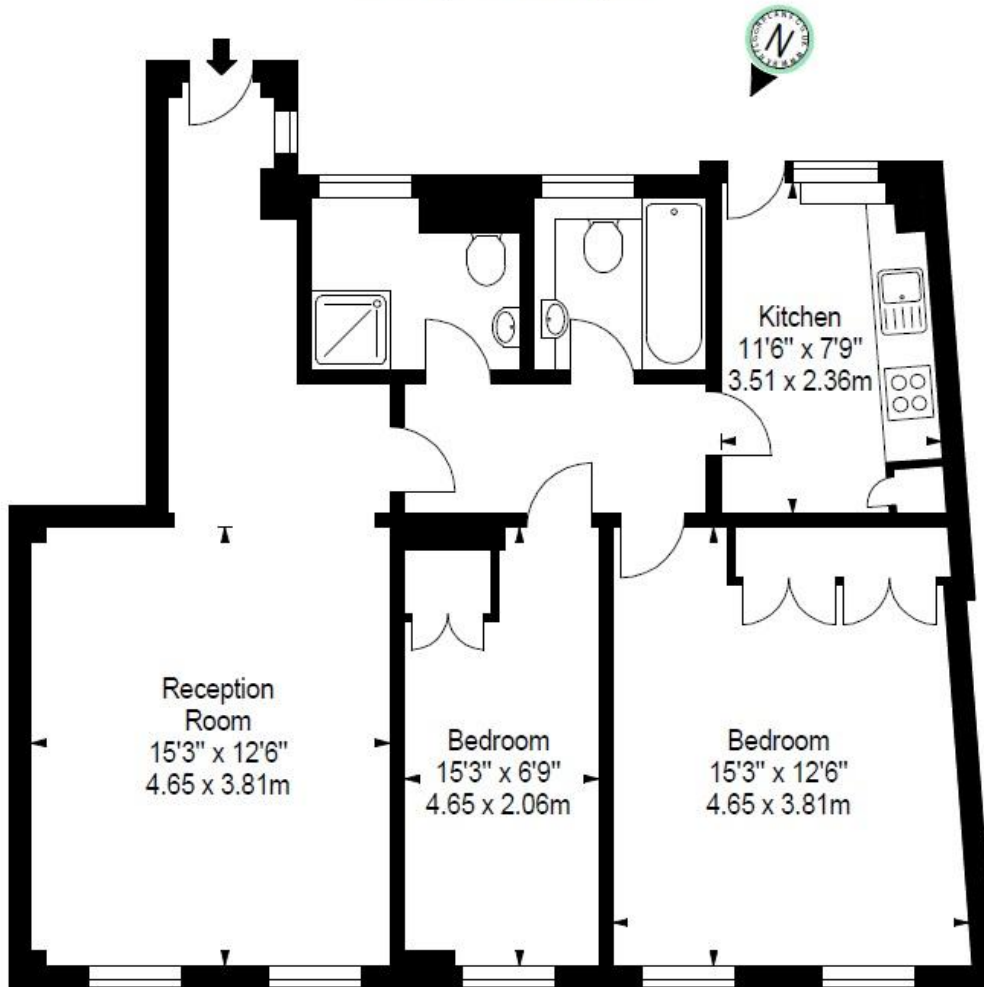
South Kensington boasts numerous shops and restaurants. The underground station is on the District, Circle and Piccadilly lines making it an excellent location for access to both the City and West London.
